

#### Government of Nepal policy/program/priority

- New constitution and new federal structure
- On-budget, aligned and result-based program support.
- Blended finance, south-south /triangular cooperation
- Visibility and transparency of aid flow to Nepal
- Digitization of Public Services and mapping of aid.
- Holistic/comprehensive information about all donors, projects,
   planned disbursement, off-budget/treasury aid
- Use of aid data- evidence based decision/policy
- Quality of data-conformity in reporting to AMIS and IATI

#### IATI and AMIS in Nepal

- AMP established in 2010; public portal in 2013
- New locally developed AMIS launched on 4 Sep 2019
- AMIS allows for IATI data import
- It has well established data fields- basis for DCR
- Nepal focus on IATI data for filling AMIS data gaps;
- IATI data import for concrete value addition
- With this in mind, MoF did rapid assessment using IATI technical team's checklist tool, to compare data availability and completeness between IATI and AMP



# **IATI** Rapid Assessment

#### Rapid Assessment findings

☐ For most data fields- equal or better data in AMP than IATI. **BUT not so in** case for forward-expenditure information. Many Nepal's biggest donors are reporting this to IATI but not to AMP.

☐ Sample findings of forward-spending data reporting:







#### General Assessment

- IATI has more data point compared to AMIS in terms of projects count but the details of the data availability depends on the organisations.
- In general, it can be said that IATI has more data from NGOs and Bilateral Agencies and on the forward looking front.
- It makes sense for the Ministry of Finance to have a mechanism to compare IATI and AMIS data for each project / donors

#### Benefits to MoF

- Have a clear understanding of missing / confusing ones on:
  - Organizations reporting to IATI but missing on AMIS
  - Projects in IATI but not in AMIS
- Use already available data in IATI after needful validation / modify existing data.
- Better coordination with non-residential donors
- Have better understanding of the aid information landscape relevant to Nepal in a single platform
- Reliability for risk assessment and negotiation  $\rightarrow$  enhance Capacity  $\rightarrow$  increased Trust  $\rightarrow$  imporived Alignment and  $\rightarrow$  increased Ownership  $\rightarrow$  end up with Sustainability.

#### **Next Steps**

- Develop a separate Interfacing platform
  - Extract Data from IATI
  - Extract Data from AMIS
  - Analysis and visualization on quality aspects and missing elements
- Conduct in-depth use case analysis focusing on 5 key donor agencies / NGOs and selected few line ministries
- Develop guideline for donor agencies to improve data quality coming into AMIS
- Promote use of aid daata at sub-national and thematic areas.
